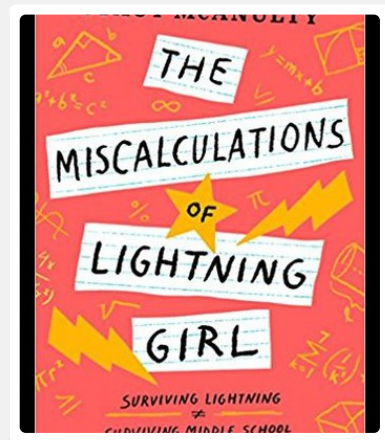
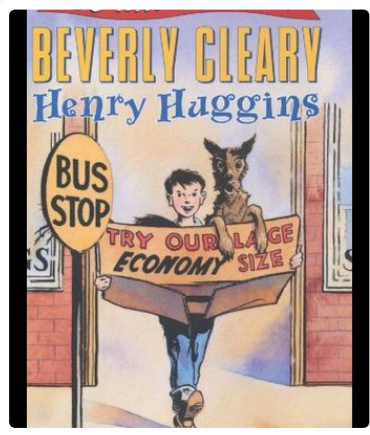


Reminder About Book Clubs

I will be adding the last chapter and video over fall break so take some time to finish up the reading and we will meet again for our last meeting on Oct. 16th after fall break.

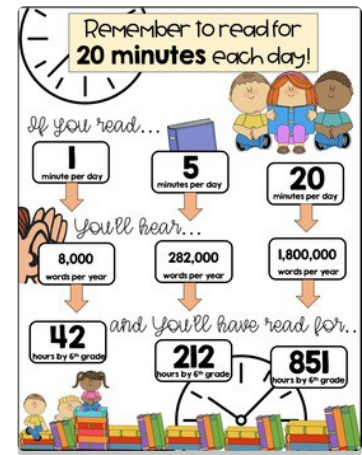
3rd and 4th will be meeting at 2:45 [Click this link to join our 3rd-4th Book Club Meeting](#)

Parents often wonder if listening to an audiobook, or a book read aloud, is as beneficial as reading the actual book. Lots of research has been done in that area and the benefits are numerous!

Morgan Gariepy, summarized it best in her article linked below, "Audiobooks are not the easy way out, and are certainly not cheating. Instead, they are a useful tool for struggling readers, a resource for advanced readers to expand their abilities even further, and a format that adapts well to busy schedules."

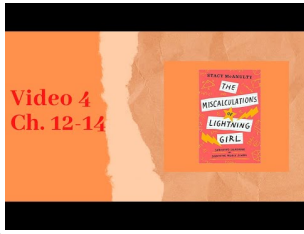
